Dear Annunciation CYO parents, parishioners and supporters of youth sports.

We would like to thank you parishioners and our parents of children who have played on our CYO basketball, volleyball and cross country teams. The amount of time you have given us to get your children to practice and games, (especially in Turlock) and supporting our teams by purchasing spirit wear, has given us the need to give something back to you.

We are pleased to inform you that we are continuing the process of renovating our gym; first we began with installing donated wall crash padding to the west end of the gym, repairing damaged sheet rock in the ceiling(donated), hanging team banners and repositioning the crucifix in the lobby and cleaning the snack bar area. As you may know, there are many areas that are in need of repair or replacement in the lobby as well as the gym. Our next step is with the gymnasium floor. We have officially received a bid to renovate the gym floor by abrading and recoating the wood floor. We would also like to fix any areas of the floor that have been water damaged (not in the bid for the refinishing of \$4,000.00).

We would like to extend our hand and ask you for your help. We are looking for donors who are willing to contribute any amount to help underwrite the cost. The gym floor renovation has been scheduled and confirmed to begin June 18-20, 2018, completed in time for CYO girls' basketball. Any amount you are willing to give will be appreciated. Even though the refinishing has been scheduled, we need to raise 100% of the funds prior to June 1st 2018. There are no funds in the 2017/18 budget for this and not anticipated that funds would be available in the 2018/19 budget. We would lose our scheduled date until the summer of 2019 if we miss the goal of \$4,500.00.

If you are interested in donating, you can submit a check, money order, or cashier's check, made out to "Cathedral of the Annunciation" and in the memo indicate CYO gym floor renovation. The tax ID # is 43-1988993. It's that simple!!!! \$20, \$50, \$100, or even \$500 would provide our young athletes a freshly coated gym floor. All funds raised will go to the ongoing renovation of the gym area.

This act of kindness will not only benefit CYO sports, but Annunciation school, Annunciation parish, and community members.
